As a candidate for public office in the 2019 Primary Election, I pledge the following:

2. I will not engage in, permit or condone personal attacks upon the character of my opponent(s); nor will I engage in invasions of personal privacy unrelated to campaign issues.
3. I will approve all materials concerning my campaign.
4. I will not use or permit the use of any campaign material or advertisement that uses quotations or images taken out of context and to misrepresent the other candidate or other candidate's message.
5. I will refuse to disseminate any campaign material or message in which I am not prominently identified.
6. I will publicly repudiate any individual or group whose activities on my campaign's behalf (directly or indirectly) violate this Fair Campaign Pledge.
